TWO TYPES OF ALERT CALLS TWO TYPES OF LOCKDOWNS

1. “Secure the Building” 3x
2. “This is a Lockdown” 3x

WHEN AND HOW

STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS

- EVERY STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTION IS PRECEDED WITH THIS STATEMENT :
“UNLESS THIS ACTION INCREASES RISK”

STEP ONE:	CLEAR HALLWAY OR OUTSIDE AREA OF INDIVIDUALS, AND LOCK DOOR(s)
STEP TWO:	CLOSE BLINDS
STEP THREE:	TURN OFF LIGHTS
STEP FOUR:	ASK KIDS TO SPREAD OUT ON FLOOR AND OUT OF SIGHT
STEP FIVE:	CELL PHONES OFF
STEP SIX:	STATUS CHECK
STEP SEVEN:	ACTUAL LOCKDOWN IS OVER WHEN DOOR IS OPENED BY ADMIN/LAW ENFORCEMENT

- ALERT AVOID DENY DEFEND
- RUN HIDE FIGHT
- RALLYING POINT EVACUATION SITE

KEY IDEAS

- NOTIFY PARENTS
- INVITE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT
- SURVEY YOUR STAFF
- STAFF MEETING SCENARIOS
- HAVE STAFF CALL LOCKDOWN DRILLS
- SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS
- PROTOCOLS FOR RALLYING POINT EVAC SITE
